***The Longwoods Award for Ph.D. research***

**Deadline June 30th, 2018**

**Purpose:** To encourage and recognize excellence in Canadian Ph.D. research. The award is intended to assist a deserving Ph.D. student to complete his/her research and engaging in knowledge dissemination and application.

**Award:** This award will be awarded every second TTRA Canada annual conference. The winning student will receive \$2000 cash award, complimentary TTRA Canada registration, and up to \$1000 toward travel and accommodation (based on submitted receipts) from TTRA Canada.

**Eligibility:** A Ph.D. student's dissertation proposal completed between June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 and May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 will be assessed. The student must be pursuing his/her Ph.D. at a Canadian university, and be a permanent resident or citizen of Canada.

**Requirements:** Eligible students must submit:

- i) A one-page cover letter that outlines the student applicant's previous involvement in tourism (academic or industry) as well as their future career goals.
- ii) A 500-word abstract that clearly describes the rationale, methods, and results of the research study.
- iii) An original electronic version of the completed Ph.D. research proposal in PDF format. The proposal may be in English or French. The proposal and its appendices must be anonymized -- the student's and supervisory committees' names and their academic institution must be redacted from the study to facilitated blind review of the submission.

**Criteria:** A review committee consisting of members of TTRA Canada and its partners will judge each Ph.D. proposal. The review committee will examine and judge the submissions based on the quality of research design, creativity/innovativeness of approach, relationship to travel and tourism, potential to advance theory and/or practice, and quality of presentation.
