

Keeling Dissertation Award (awarded every 2 years; in even years)

Awarded to a doctoral student for their completed thesis or dissertation.

Requirements: All doctoral students enrolled (or previously enrolled) in a degree-granting program are eligible to submit an abstract of a completed, original dissertation of 1,000-1,500 words and must include an introduction, theory, methods, results, conclusions. On the cover page please include name, university graduated from, advisors name, and title of dissertation. Entry for this award may not be submitted for any other TTRA award. This work should have been completed between March 31, 2018 and March 30, 2020, as an enrolled doctoral student.

Criteria: The papers will be judged by a review committee who will examine the quality of research, contribution to scholarship, relationship to travel and tourism, usefulness/applicability, and quality of the paper.

Award: The winning student will receive plaque and a \$1,000 cash award, airfare, hotel accommodations, and a complimentary registration to the TTRA International Conference. The winning student will also receive a complimentary TTRA professional membership for one (1) year.

**Round-trip travel to the conference and lodging arrangement will be made and paid for TTRA.*
